

TELEMEDICINE Visit Instructions

Telemedicine appointments are made available for college students who need to discuss medications taken on an ongoing basis. We much prefer to see patients face-to-face in the office. In fact, if we do a telemedicine visit the next visit **must** be in the office. All college students on medication should be seen during the summer and winter breaks, at the minimum. Failure to maintain this visit schedule may jeopardize ongoing prescriptions for medication. Telemedicine appointments are limited. Once the appointment is made each patient should go to the local health service and record a height, weight and blood pressure. Have this information ready when you start your visit.

Below are the instructions to access the telemedicine website. **PLEASE NOTE: patients are still responsible for their regular PCP copayment associated with this encounter.**

1. Call the office at (410)721-0800 to schedule a telemedicine appointment, these appointments are limited.
2. **5-10 minutes prior** to your scheduled appointment time, go to: www.doxy.me/belliacrespeds using a Google Chrome or Moxzilla browser **ONLY**.
3. The computer you are using to access the telemedicine website must have a camera in order to video-chat with the doctor.
4. Once on the website, the patient should sign in using **the patients full name** and will then be virtually placed in the "waiting room".
5. Once in the waiting room, the doctor will then connect to the patient to begin the telemedicine appointment.
